Jeff Doucet-Grant

- Alzheimer's disease Initiative – Specialized Supportive Services Program.
- Grant status: Letter of intent
- \$300,000 dollar match, \$1.3 million dollar total for Nevada.
- Main Objective: Start with targeted communities, and grow from there. Should not specifically tell what community members what to do, but the community tells what they need. What should we enhance? We want to grow this across the state. Minimum of the 4 criteria. Criteria listed on ACL.gov document. Idea is to instill this community and sustained by the community.
- Access is the issue. People do not know where to go. Our system needs to guide people before they need it.
- Grant Identifies:
 - Adult daycare
 - Companion services
 - Respite care
 - Home healthcare
 - Healthcare facilities
 - Short term care in a health care facility
- ACL webpage.
- 30% must be for direct services.
- Grant due in July.
